1. FOLLOWING INFO REC'D 1710R FROM CAPT. JACKSON, (OP-921);

LEE HARVEY OSWALD, DOB 18 OCT 39, NEW ORLEANS, LA.

ONE-HALF HOUR AFTER PRES. WAS SHOT OSWALD WAS STOPPED IN DALLAS BY TWO POLICEMEN, OSWALD SHOT AND KILLED ONE POLICEMAN AND WAS CAPTURED BY THE OTHER POLICEMAN. OSWALD WORKS IN THE BUILDING (TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY, 411 M^{ST.}, DALLAS) THE BUILDING FROM WHICH (6th FLOOR) THE PRES WAS SHOT. FIVE PEOPLE HAVE IDENTIFIED OSWALD AS BEING IN THE BUILDING AT THE TIME OF THE SHOOTING. THE RIFLE USED WAS FOUND ON A BACK STAIRWAY IN THIS BUILDING. IT IS OF ITALIAN MANUFACTURE.

OSWALD WENT TO RUSSIA ABOUT 3 YEARS AGO AND TRIED TO RENOUNCE HIS U.S. CITIZENSHIP. HE WAS DISCHARGED FROM THE USMC BECAUSE OF THIS TRIP. OSWALD HAS A HALF BROTHER NAMED EDWARD J. PICK WHO IS SAID TO BE WILD AND CRAZY, HIS CONNECTION WITH THE CRIME IS UNKNOWN AT PRESENT. SEE ATTACHED CIA MSG 102012Z OCT 63.



This is a synopsis of events at this Center on this date from approximately 1600 through 2400, prepared on the spot, and to the best of my recollection.

1. 222147Z NAVCSUPPCEN TWX requested MARCORPS record check on Oswald. ONI files indicated that Oswald had been separated from the MARCORPS in 1960.
2. DIO 9ND TWX 222223Z stated jacket mailed this P.M. to HQ USMC WASH. D.C. Maj. Vanderswag stated service record not available until at least Monday.
3. 1700 - Mr. Pascal delivered supplemental file to Intelligence Plot.
4. 1900- ONI investigative file received at Center and reviewed by Capt Johnson. Capt Jackson and Adm. Taylor informed.
5. At approximately 1930 Captain Johnson placed a call to Special FBI Agent Williams in Dallas, and gave him the gist of a letter from Oswald to Connally who had been SECNAV.
6. Meanwhile, ONI duty officer had been informed of a request being prepared from General Carroll of DIA to see the file on Oswald.
7. Admiral Taylor and Capt Jackson advised of this request by Captain Johnson at approximately 2000.
8. Admiral Taylor's instructions were to prepare a file for him to be passed to General Carroll. This file is to be carried to Admiral Taylor's office by special agent Bliss who will then carry the file to General Carroll who will peruse the file and return it to the special agent.
9. At approximately 2200 I received a call from the Intelligence Duty Officer that I was to release no files to anyone except by his order. However, I received his permission to prepare copies of the files for possible use by Secret Service, FBI, and other possible authorized activities.
9. Copies of Oswald's letter are being transmitted to FBI, and Secret Service on 23 November.

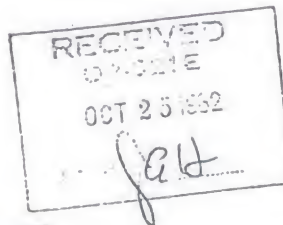

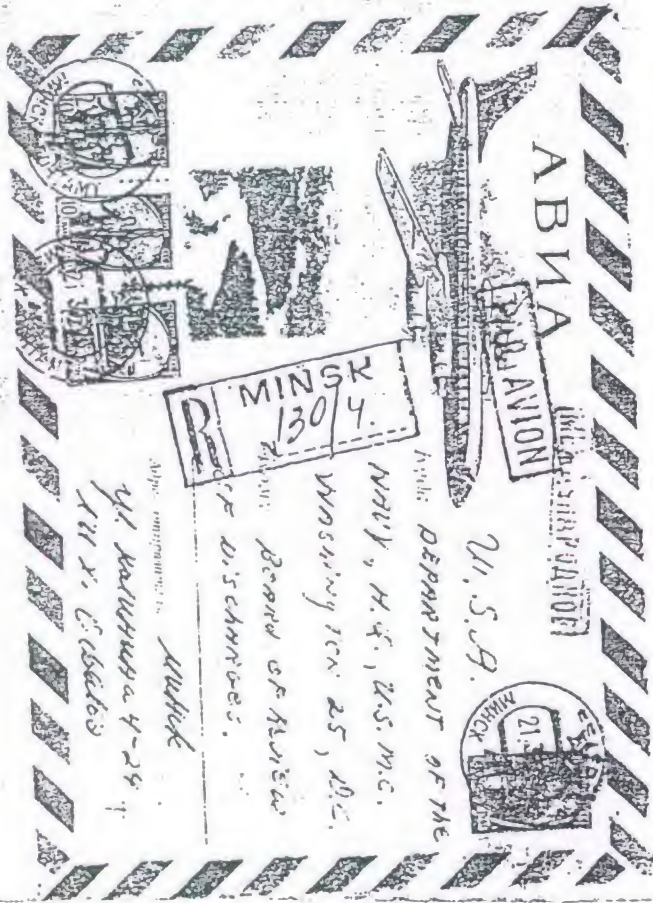

Dear Mr. Oswald:

Your letter of 30 January 1962 addressed to the Secretary of the Navy concerning your separation from the Marine Corps Reserve on 13 September 1960 has been referred to me for reply.

A review of your file at this Headquarters reflects that a board of officers was convened by the Commander, Marine Air Reserve Training, Naval Air Station, Glenview, Illinois, for the purpose of determining your fitness to remain a member of the Marine Corps Reserve. Referral of your case to this board was premised on reliable information which indicated that you had renounced your United States citizenship with the intentions of becoming a permanent citizen of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics. The Commander, Marine Air Reserve Training, made reasonable effort to inform you of your right to appear before the board in person, representation by counsel of your choice and to present any evidence or statements you believed pertinent to your case.

In the absence of reply from you concerning your rights as noted above, the board, nevertheless, convened and met on 8 August 1960 at which time a recommendation was submitted that you be separated from the Marine Corps Reserve as undesirable. This recommendation was concurred in by the Commander, Marine Air Reserve Training and approved by this Headquarters. Your discharge as undesirable was directed by this Headquarters on 17 August 1960 and effected 13 September 1960.

Your discharge certificate as undesirable is attached. Earlier delivery of your certificate could not be accomplished since your whereabouts previously was unknown.

1. Reference (A) indicated that on 31 October 1959 OSWALD visited the U. S. Embassy, Moscow, where he signed a handwritten statement requesting that his U.S. citizenship be revoked, stated he had applied for Soviet citizenship, and affirmed his allegiance to the USSR. He allegedly told Embassy he had advised unnamed Soviet Officials that as a former Marine radar operator, he would make available to them information about his Marine Corps specialty when he became a Soviet citizen.

2. By personal letter to Secretary of the Navy CONNALLY dated 30 January 1961, received in February 1962, OSWALD advised he was preparing to return to the USA and wished to have rectified the "gross injustice" done to him by the USMC in giving him a "belated dishonourable discharge." He stated he had received an honorable discharge after three years service on September 11, 1959. In this letter, OSWALD asserted he was still a U.S. citizen and alleged he had gone to the Soviet Union to reside only for a "short time." Records of the Office of Naval Intelligence do not indicate what OSWALD's citizenship is.

Dear Sir,

I wish to call your attention to a case about which you may have personal knowledge since you are a resident of Ft. Worth as I am.

In November, 1959 an event was well publicized in the Ft. Worth newspapers concerning a person who had gone to the Soviet Union to reside for a short time, (much in the same way E. Hemingway resided in Paris).

This person in answer to questions put to him by reporters in Moscow criticized certain facets of American life, the story was blown up into another "turncoat" sensation, with the result that the Navy Department gave this person a belated dishonorable discharge, although he had received an honorable discharge after three years service on Sept. 11, 1959 at El Toro, Marine Corps Base in California.

These are the basic facts of my case.

I have and always had the full sanction of the U.S. Embassy, Moscow U.S.S.R. and hence the U.S. government. In as much as I am returning to the U.S.A. in this year with the aid of the U.S. Embassy (bring with me my family) since I married in the U.S.A. I shall employ all means to right this gross mistake or injustice to a born-fee'd U.S. citizen and ex-serviceman. The U.S. government has no charges or complaints against me. I ask you to look into this case and take the necessary steps to repair the damage done to me and my family. For information I would direct you to consult the American Embassy, Chirkovski St. 19/21, Moscow, U.S.S.R.

The Department of the Navy, however, is not to be identified outside the Executive Branch of the Government as the source of the information, nor is the Department of the Navy to be identified as the source of the information to the subject or to any other individual mentioned in the report.

- e. All information extracted or obtained will be classified in accordance with the classification of the source report, unless otherwise authorized by appropriate Naval authority. If unclassified, the material will be designated "For Official Use Only." The information will be protected in accordance with the assigned classification or designation.

- f. The names of any confidential source will not be recorded, nor will any other data which would tend to identify such sources, without specific permission from appropriate Naval Authority.

- g. I am aware that unauthorized disclosure of the information obtained would constitute a violation of the Espionage Laws (Title 18, U.S.C., section 793), or of official directives of the Secretary of the Navy.
